Investment Objective

To provide equal emphasis on long-term capital growth and capital preservation.

Investment Strategy

The portfolio is invested in a moderately conservative mix of securities that seeks to balance growth and capital preservation for a more stable rate of return relative to an investment in the stock market. Holdings are diversified primarily among intermediate to long-term fixed income securities. Because this fund is designed to moderate risk, stocks will typically be a minority in the portfolio, unless the fund manager's analysis shows that the stock market is especially attractive.

The fund manager will adjust the investment mix over time to manage risk by continually evaluating individual securities and market conditions to determine the relative attractiveness of each investment. In general, stock exposure will increase when valuations are low and decrease during speculative markets.

Pro-Blend® Moderate Term Series I was rated against Moderately Conservative Allocation funds and had a 3 star rating for the three year, a 4 star rating for the five year, a 4 star rating for the five year, a 4 star rating for the five year, a 4 star rating overall, as of 06/30/2024, out of 446, 410, 305, and 446 funds respectively. Ratings for other share classes may differ. The Momingstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for managed products (including mutual funds, variable annuity and variable life subaccounts, exchange-traded funds, closed-end funds, and separate accounts) with at least a three-year history.
